ASPIRE is a program aimed to increase community capacity to build a protective environment against substance misuse, HIV, and hepatitis infection. APAIT aims to increase access to culturally appropriate substance abuse prevention services. We will also increase availability of HIV and hepatitis screenings and linkage to care. Our intent is to increase knowledge and awareness to practice safer drug use and sex behaviors. A new and unique component to our program is a focus on increasing access to shelter and support services.
