
Alliance for Housing and Healing's Group Homes Program

The Alliance Group Home Program is a state-licensed program designed to serve persons living with HIV/AIDS who are unable to perform activities of daily living to meet their personal needs. The program provides nutritious meals and 24/7 support by Certified Nursing Assistants, RN Case Managers, MSW, and an LCSW.



- MEDICAL ELIGIBILITY -

- HIV/AIDS Diagnosis (*Current form with CD4 & VL)
- Karnofsky Score of 70% or below
- Age 18 or older

Please Note: Our RCFCI program services are transitional housing to improve the health status of people living with HIV/AIDS who need to receive support with medication management, assistance and supervision with ADLs in a stable living environment in order to transition to self-sufficiency and permanent housing. **Clients that just need housing may not meet the health status eligibility requirements.** Our facilities are a drug and alcohol-free environment that require residents to have 6 months sobriety to enter our program. We also conduct random testing in our facilities.
