### WHAT IS HOPWA?

The Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program is a program dedicated to addressing the housing needs of people living with HIV. HOPWA helps fund housing assistance and supportive services for individuals with HIV who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness.

# -HOPWA Housing Specialty

\*Where individuals can receive support with emergency services such as:

-Shelter

-Legal services

-Basic needs

-Mental health services

### OTHER SERVICES MAY INCLUDE:

-Short-Term Rent, Mortgage, and Utility (STRMU)
Assistance

\*A needs based program providing assistance to HOPWA eligible households experiencing financial crisis.

- -Permanent Housing Placement (PHP)
  - \* For individuals in need of move-in assistance, such as utility switch-on fees, first month's rent and security deposit.

\*Services vary per Client\*

# WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals must have

- (1) HIV Diagnosis Form
- (2) Proof of Income
- (3) Recent Tuberculosis Test
