A Family-Focused Approach

The Dads Back! Academy F.I.R.E. provides a helpful and caring environment where you can learn skills to overcome obstacles during reentry.

Our four primary workshops are designed for you to build your parenting and relationship skills and strengthen your family.

Re-Entry Parenting

Focused on mending, maintaining and managing the relationship between a child and parent, from incarceration through reentry.

Healthy Relationships (Within My Reach)

Focused on building communication skills; conflict management; making good choices in romantic relationships and the significance of fathers.

Fatherhood (TYRO)

Focused on the parent-child relationship, including the role and responsibility of being a father; overcoming obstacles; identifying family cycles that need to be broken; and what makes a strong family.

Employment (P2P)

A job readiness curriculum designed specifically for reentry job seekers.




Re-Entry Fatherhood Program

Eligibility:

- Fathers with biological children, step-children or children in your care.
- Have a child or young adult up to 24 years of age, regardless of current relationship status.
- Have a criminal background regardless of the time gap, including transitional housing and/or community supervision
