



LA Family Housing helps nearly 5,000 children, parents, and individuals end the cycle of homelessness through a continuum of housing enriched with supportive services.

92% of funds go directly to programs

765 families helped by case managers

1514 individuals engaged by street outreach

174 veterans assisted with housing

We believe that permanent, affordable housing combined with supportive services is the key to achieving personal long-term stability. As a result, 92% of families who leave our transitional shelter retain permanent housing.


AFFORDABLE HOUSING
