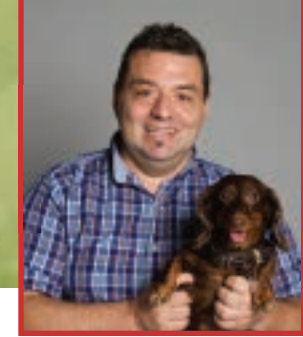

Services may include: veterinary care; pet food and supplies; grooming; temporary foster care and services such as dog walking and pet transport for homebound individuals.
