1736 Family Crisis Center is a private, nonprofit organization dedicated to ensuring the safety of runaway and homeless youth, domestic violence victims and their children, and homeless and at-risk military Veterans and to improving their prospects for long-term survival and success. Founded in 1972, the Center is a leader in the provision of cutting-edge prevention and treatment services and specialized technical assistance and training that benefits over 25,000 each year, including 5,000 through direct services. Our program services include:

- Emergency shelter for runaway, throwaway, and homeless girls and boys ages 10-17, located in Hermosa Beach
- Four emergency/transitional shelters for battered women and their children, girls and boys ages birth through 17, located at confidential sites in South Los Angeles, Redondo Beach, and Long Beach
- Three community service centers offering children, teens, and adults in crisis outpatient individual, group, and family counseling, located in South Los Angeles, Long Beach, and Torrance
- Full-scale legal services specializing in family law, particularly as regards victims of domestic violence
- Homelessness prevention and intervention services for very low-income Veterans and their families in Los Angeles and Orange counties
- Five 24-hour crisis and suicide hotlines
- FamilySource Center offering low-income families in the City of Los Angeles access to economic empowerment services, including benefits enrollment, free tax preparation, and employment support, as well as youth academic advancement support
- CalWORKs (welfare-to-work) and other specialized job training, placement, counseling, and support services for domestic violence victims
- Extensive community outreach and education in schools, health care settings, service clubs, and at community events
