The Regional Center and Satellite offices are your entry into the HOPWA system of resources and services that will assist you with your housing needs. Through the Regional Center and satellite offices you can access: case management assistance; Section 8 and affordable housing listings; financial rental assistance programs; housing information; legal services; support animal advocacy and information; and many other supportive services that can eliminate barriers for People Living with HIV/AIDS to finding and maintaining permanent housing.
