**A New Way of Life's** national and international collective of partner nonprofits are dedicated to working towards decarceration by bringing people home to stay while helping them to heal from the trauma of incarceration, as well as empowering them to lead in the fight to end mass incarceration. The **S.A.F.E.** Housing Network restores individuals to move from surviving to thriving, from helpless to helpful, and from voiceless to advocates.



Recognizing that, historically, women have been overlooked in the incarceration conversation and service provision, women also receive significantly less support than men. We ensure women, including LGBTQ+ women, find safety and support, and go from surviving to thriving.

Established in 2018, **S.A.F.E.** has given a new face to women's reentry opportunities and members receive an array of support from technical assistance, communication, and coaching across the world. The **S.A.F.E.** replication model and framework supports formerly incarcerated people and provides safe passage for women reentering into their community and reunites them with their families and children. We address issues of social and mental health and drug addictions.



Members of the network receive training annually and technical support from **A New Way of Life** for implementing our reentry model. Our best practice model was created by and for formerly incarcerated people and boasts a recidivism rate significantly lower than the national average with an over 80% success rate.



Our success rate is attributed to understanding the value of those that we work with and serve, the strength of our replication model, and the leadership of network partners that centers around dignity and respect and values the potential of the people we serve.

**S.A.F.E.** is poised to create a new and different approach to the successful reentry of women.
