

## Transitional Housing Beds Available



Alliance for Housing and Healing provides HOPWA funded transitional housing program for single, unaccompanied males. This is a 12-month transitional living program in which clients, in accordance with HOPWA regulations, will be required to pay 30% of their monthly income towards their rent.

### Location:

Community Empowerment & Resource Consultants, (CERC) and Pathways to Your Future [www.ptyf.org](http://www.ptyf.org) has two facilities located in South Los Angeles with single double occupancy rooms, as well as shared common areas. (CERC) provides 24-hour supervision, three meals per day, Wi-Fi, and laundry facilities on site. Participants are encouraged to go about their days if they are involved with other activities such as support groups, work, housing search etc.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Must meet HOPWA eligibility criteria:
  - o HIV diagnosis
  - o Income that does not exceed 80% of the HUD's Area Median Income (AMI)
- Clients referred for these transitional housing beds will be required to work with a HOPWA Housing Specialist in the SPA 4/5 area and be actively working on a housing plan.

### Referrals must include the following supporting documentation:

- Diagnosis, dated within the last 12 months
- TB Clearance, dated within the 6 months
- COVID-19 testing clearance
- Identification Card (ID)
- Verification of income from the last 30 days
- Homeless status verification of where client spends most of their time (Zip code)
- Consent to Release of Information signed by client
- Enclosed referral form
