At the Los Angeles Mission we seek to break the cycle of homelessness and poverty, by stabilizing people in a safe and spiritual environment, connecting them to solutions and walking with them on their journey. To this end helping our students, and the community at large, to prepare through skills development, GED completion, resume building, interviewing preparation, and other career development training is our priority.



Expanding Our Partnerships

Our goal is to expand our partnerships with external agencies to provide more streamlined employment opportunities into competitive careers. We strive to ensure our clients obtain employment within these new entities.



Employment Placement Services

We offer employment placement services and outreach for unemployed students and the homeless community we serve. This includes a complete career assessment and virtual and in-person job fairs.



Employment Classes and Trainings

We hold financial literacy and computer skills classes. We also hold job readiness and academic/vocational trainings. Our standard is 95% of clients taking a class or training will complete a career assessment and after attending at least one class or training will obtain employment each grant year.



Provide Outpatient Counseling and Supportive Services

In order to ensure continued workplace success after discharge, we provide outpatient counseling and supportive services.



Clinical Services

We offer clinical services to our clients including, but not limited to Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Motivational Interviewing, and Seeking Safety.
