WHAT IS HOPWA?

The Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program is a program dedicated to addressing the housing needs of people living with HIV. HOPWA helps fund housing assistance and supportive services for individuals with HIV who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness.

Let Us Help You Navigate The HOPWA System!

RECEIVE REFERRALS FOR:

-HOPWA Housing Specialty

*Where individuals can receive support with emergency services such as:

- Shelter
- Legal services
- Basic needs
- Mental health services

OTHER SERVICES MAY INCLUDE:

-Short-Term Rent, Mortgage, and Utility (STRMU) Assistance

*A needs based program providing assistance to HOPWA eligible households experiencing financial crisis.

-Permanent Housing Placement (PHP)

* For individuals in need of move-in assistance, such as utility switch-on fees, first month's rent and security deposit.

Services vary per Client

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals must have

- (1) HIV Diagnosis Form
- (2) Proof of Income
- (3) Recent Tuberculosis Test
