Housing Stability Success Workshop

The CHIRP/LA Housing Stability Success Program (Housing 101) is a one-day workshop geared toward people who are living with HIV/AIDS and seeking permanent housing. They may have had difficulty finding or remaining in permanent housing due to credit history, health concerns, affordability, gaps in employment, substance abuse, a criminal record, or medical complications. The program addresses these critical issues by partnering with knowledgeable experts and working with the client's Housing Specialist, who assists them with finding and maintaining housing. The program presents resources to help the participants obtain permanent housing and improve their quality of life. It is beneficial for individuals who have a Section 8 voucher.

- Budgeting
- Medication Compliance
- Tenant Rights and Responsibilities
- Application Process
- Credit Scores
