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**Housing Program Details**

- Our housing programs are transitional programs designed for families and homeless individuals who need an extended amount of time to address barriers.
- Participants can use and save a portion of their income to pay back Major debt such as credit card debts ,vehicle payments, previous evictions, credit repair or any financial barriers that would prevent them from getting Stabilized permanent housing.
- Families and individuals can live at one of our homes for up to 24 months and in some cases, there is no end date to the program.

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Cost Breakdown:

- Pay is based off tenant's income and ability to pay after receiving rental assistance
- (I.E) A client that gets ssi or disability monthly would pay \$1600.00 deposit \$850.00 a month all bills and meals included everything that the home has to offer
- OR \$750 a month and client pays for \$200.00 a month for there portion of the food

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How It Works

- If the client was on pilot program they would qualify for the \$1000.00 deposit \$650 a month rent and \$200.00 a month food
- If the client was not able to pay for food we would allow them to put in community service hours in our garden or one of our homes and still get the 3 meals 2 snacks a day
- If agency is willing to pay rental assistance on behalf of the client for a set amount, then we would ask the agency for at least 3 to 6 months of rental assistance in advance
- we request this time-frame of assistance, so that we have time to put measures in place to make sure clients don't return to being homeless and can afford rent, once the rental assistance program ends

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Lease Agreement and what's included

- Lease ranges from a 3-6 month basis
- All utilities included with client's rental payment
- We charge per bed
- families will get the lowest discounts which would be the \$650 program as well for each member over age 2 with \$1800 deposit
- limit for families is 2 children per family

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
