- Survivors Speak, which brings crime victims together to share stories, heal together and advocate for change.

WOJO trains those directly impacted by criminal justice, governmental and economic systems in how laws and policies are created, while giving members the tools they need to effect positive changes within those systems.



Graduates of the WOJO training program are celebrated in an annual ceremony with acknowledgement and proclamations from public officials.

Each year we train a cohort of women to sharpen their leadership skills and get involved in the movement for social justice. Our aim is to eliminate discrimination and improve conditions for formerly incarcerated women and people with criminal convictions.

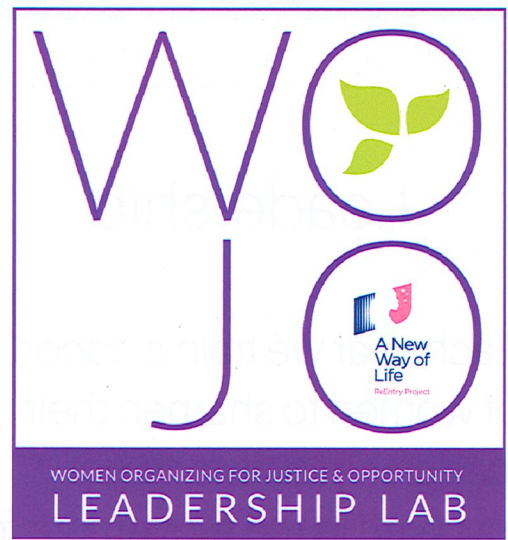
